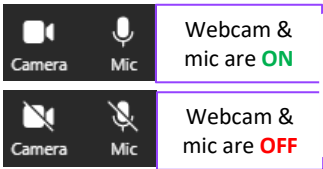


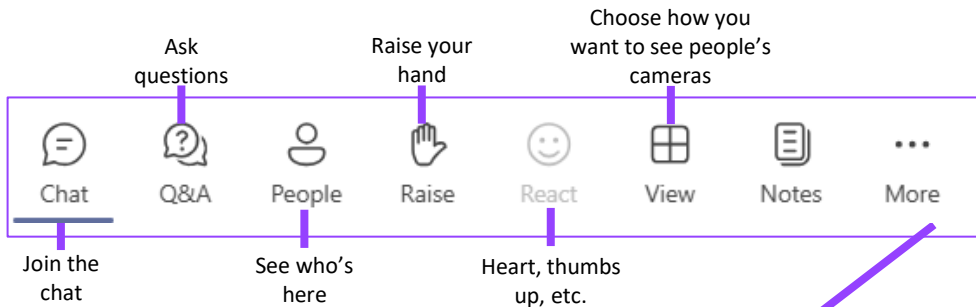

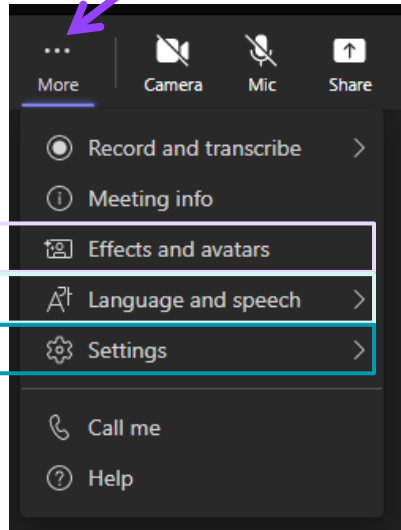

Shatterproof Pillars



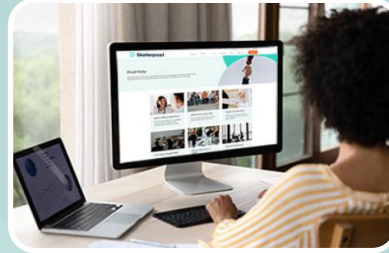
Transforming addiction treatment

Quick, easy ways to take action

Goal: Spread awareness & build community power

- No training needed, just basic understanding of who Shatterproof is
- One-time or ongoing opportunities
- **Examples:** awareness building, writing cards, tabling, sharing resources, general walk volunteering



Connectors

More intentional engagement

Goal: Take meaningful action and connect others to the mission

- Some training and deeper understanding of Shatterproof's work
- One-on-one conversations, targeted outreach support
- **Examples:** volunteer recruitment events, Shatterproof support events, opportunities to build network, Walk Committee



Ambassadors

Deeply engaged, trained leaders

Goal: Be a true extension of the Shatterproof team

- Represent Shatterproof in your community
- Ongoing commitment, full training, strategic involvement
- **Examples:** NYC Junior Council, high-level lunch & learns, CYOF public speaking, media partnerships

Andree interns with **Shatterproof**, supporting community outreach and the 2025 Walks to End Addiction Stigma. She started a **Naloxone “little library”** at her home, and each year has an **Overdose Memorial Christmas Tree** to honor others who have lost loved ones to substance use disorder. She has participated in the last three walks in both Los Angeles and New York honoring her son who passed away from Fentanyl poisoning in 2022.
